A little bit Michael Caine and a whole lot Steve McQueen, Austin's definitive men's boutique for all things rich and rugged, **STAG**, is set to open in Dallas this month. In September, the shop expanded west to Venice, California, outfitting stylish guys there seeking everything from the perfect RRL leather bomber to a chambray shirt for every season. Now it's Dallas' turn, with a temporary space at 4539 Travis Street, near Knox

Street, followed by a permanent location on Cole Street in late 2015. Co-owners Don Weir and Steve Shuck impeccably stock their shelves with contemporary staples with classic roots from the likes of Hamilton Shirt Co., Jack Spade, Filson and Imogene + Willie, mixed in with unique vintage finds — art, furniture, even taxidermy. What's more, Stag also proffers a small collection of coffee-table books, magazines and home accessories, such as Malin + Goetz's intoxicating Dark Rum candle.
