concrete weight pipeline coating services for the oil and gas industry. The site is service by rail, truck and barge.

The company estimates that it will coat over 26,000 tons of pipe at the facility on North Line Road over the next several months. 38 local jobs were created since construction of the facility was initiated.

In March 2015, Stupp Coatings requested a one-year extension on its lease with the Port of Greater Baton Rouge as a result of an additional contract to coat 147,000 feet of 24" line pipe.
