The Clemmons Community Care Crew Invites You to Walk To Jerusalem

Last year the **Clemmons Community Care Crew's** "Walk to Jerusalem" was an exciting journey that helped participants focus on caring for their minds, bodies and spirits. This year we invite you to once again, to walk with us to Jerusalem beginning Saturday, January 31 and **arriving in Jerusalem by Palm Sunday, March 29**. Our


goal will be to walk (cumulatively) from Clemmons, N.C. to Jerusalem (a total of 6,135 miles).

As we focus our minds, we will explore the places we will pass through along the way. We challenge you and your family to discover facts about the places we will travel, including the people, customs, major cities, geography, climate, form of government and other interesting facts. Try to discover information about the country today and during the time of the Roman Empire. Our trip will take us across the Atlantic Ocean to Algeria, Libya, Sudan and Egypt. As we leave Egypt, we will walk in the footsteps of the children of Israel as we cross the Red Sea before completing our journey in Jerusalem.

As we focus on our bodies, we walk the 6,135 miles to Jerusalem. To encourage everyone's participation on this journey, our definition of "walk" will be an expanded. "Walking" one mile will equal 20 minutes of active physical exercise for example: walking, jogging, and swimming, participating in any exercise class or sport. Children may include time in gym, dance class, gymnastics, sports practices/games and playing outside.

As we focus on our spirit, we will spend time in daily devotion and prayer. There will be scripture verses and reflections available to use during our journey.

As we preview of coming events, did you know it has been estimated that during his lifetime Jesus walked 21,525 miles? During 2015, in addition to the "Walk to Jerusalem," the Clemmons Community Care Crew will also be sponsoring other walking journeys. As we walk we will follow in the steps of Jesus's and Paul's ministry, go in search of the Wise Men and walk in the steps of Mary and Joseph as they travel to Bethlehem for the birth of the Savior. 
