WORSHIP IN FEBRUARY: During the Epiphany season (which includes the feast of *The Transfiguration of Our Lord* on **Sunday, March 2**nd), we will continue to pray Divine Service, Setting Three from *Lutheran Service Book* in Sunday worship. This month, we also look forward to a special festival: **Sunday, February 2**nd, forty days after Christmas, when we will celebrate *The Purification of Mary & the Presentation of Our Lord.* We are especially delighted that our preschool children will serve as our choir that morning, as we observe the end of *National Lutheran Schools Week*!

Our February *Hymn of the Month* has a long history that crosses centuries and continents! The Latin hymn "Ubi caritas et amor" ("Where charity and love are, there God is") dates back to the time of Charlemagne, inspired by Jesus' words in Matthew 18:20 ("for where two or three are gathered in My name, there am I among them"). Over the years, it became a hymn associated with Maundy Thursday, commemorating Jesus' washing of the disciples' feet and pointing to the

There God is ever found;

Brought here together by Christ's love

By love are we thus bound.

forgiveness and peace He won for us on the cross. The English translation "Where Charity and Love Prevail" (number 845 in *Lutheran Service Book*) is by American Catholic musician and publisher Omer Westendorf.

From the Parish Assistant, Continued:

Whether in the original language or in translation, this hymn has been set to music by countless composers (a brand-new setting by American composer Dan Forrest will be included in upcoming Grand Rapids Symphony concerts on March 6th and 7th). The LSB melody is a tune in the style of Appalachian folk music written by American Presbyterian music master Lucius Chapin; it was originally published around 1812 (with the oldest surviving copy found in the University of Michigan's rare book collection).

"Where Charity and Love Prevail" is a powerful expression of the God-given faith that binds us to Jesus Christ and to each other. Whether you are returning to this hymn or discovering it for the first time, we hope that you enjoy singing it and learning it by heart, beginning on **Sunday, February 2**nd.
