

#### Here's a run-down of the responsibilities of the position:

As head of operations, you'll build and implement turn-key systems that power LunchOwl outside of the kitchen.

#### **Daily Service Preparation**

- Organize and review daily production report for our kitchen team.
- Print and organize lunch name cards / pull tickets.
- Print warming instruction notes and lunch notes.
- Print marketing collateral for delivery team to display at partner companies.
- Write birthday cards and first time welcome cards.
- Generate and print labels for delivery totes.
- Generate a report for the kitchen team with a summary of orders for the remaining days of the week.

#### **Lunch Delivery**

- Recruit, train, and manage delivery drivers.
- Organize daily delivery route logistics.
- Manage the delivery logistics software that we use to guide our drivers.

#### Weekly Menu Setup

- Generate detailed menu document and persona recommendations.
- · Setup weekly menu in our web app.
- Layout a print version of the menu.
- Guide software development of our menu structure and flow.

#### Launch LunchOwl at New Partner Companies

- Work with our contact at new companies to setup a launch calendar.
- Organize start-up paperwork.
- Upload employee roster to our system.
- Execute marketing plan for new guests.
- Organize and present at intro lunch.
- Coordination the delivery and installation of new fridge.
- Re-market the program at set intervals after launch.

#### **Coordinate Catering Orders**

- Work with customers to setup their boxed lunch catering order.
- Integrate order into appropriate kitchen reports.
- Integrate order into delivery route.
- Follow up to ensure the guest delight.
- Create invoices.

#### **Facility**

- Oversee LunchOwl's presence at our partner companies. (Fridge condition and cleanliness, decals, flatware, signage, etc.)
- Work with our vendors to design and purchase fridges, custom rack units, decals, flatware, reusable lunch packaging, and other supplies.
- Oversee the preventative maintenance and service of our delivery fleet.

#### **Guest Support**

- Oversee all communication with our guests and ensure that they feel heard and know that we're on their side.
- Coordinate efforts with our guest support manager.
- Proactively go above and beyond for our guests to create raves and build loyalty and trust.

#### People, Management, and Leadership

- Establish systems and guidelines for recruiting, screening, training, and managing employees to support our Cleveland operation and future growth.
- Help create a culture where we put our employees first and where they know we truly care about their well-being.
- Many of the items listed here will be delegated to new team members as we grow. Coach and provide feedback to them daily. Hold one-on-ones on a weekly basis.
- Model and teach our core values daily.
