THOUGHTS FROM PAULA'S JOURNAL



l've been thinking about the early beginnings of Red Bird Foundation, and how we set our intention to be an organization who tends the invisible needs and healing of the human heart. I notice how even in this year when our "in person" work has shifted to Zoom and online retreats, this intention hasn't wavered. In my Inbox yesterday morning was a single spaced three and a half page email from a woman in Africa. The first two pages were her heart's cry, her story of abuse and

trauma and the words, "I am so broken."

Attached to the email was an illustration she'd drawn of herself as a tree rising from roots buried in the earth, with spring shoots arising from her wounds. Her opening contemplation of this beautiful picture begins, "The dry twig is alive, the life is hidden." It is increasingly clear that we must open to each other in new ways, discovering together that the dry twig is alive, and it is ours to water with our lives and hearts.

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In these long months of pandemic we have been witness to many things needing our care and protection – things that must change. To name just two, there is the deep suffering caused by racial injustice, and the irreversible damage already done to the Earth, our home. Everywhere is evidence of the heartbreaking cost of our silence and inaction. A greater love reaches through these experiences with a great invitation for us to wake up from our slumber. There is so much change needed, and so much to heal.

MINISTERING THROUGH THE PANDEMIC
