Apart from the United States, especially northern regions like Canada and Scandinavia -- the royal family when it comes to popular genres like folk and country. Also from our own kitchen comes much beauty. So that you do not always have to look far.

You might almost forget that ever authentic sounds from the south of the US here are blown over. For pure country music you're in Texas always chiseled and as you listen to this excellent album of new Americana promise Brant Croucher, you only hear very well how deep the songwriter tradition is rooted in that environment .

Blanco Country Lights is an exemplary Americana plate. The deforestation in the compositions of the eleven songs shoot the parched and desolate landscape slowly. Thereby know the beautiful, clear and calm voice of the singer born in Houston to create the right balance between tough and sensitive. The pleasant atmosphere on the album leaves the listener return regularly to this silent world.

The neat, almost perfect songs Croucher are all beautiful acoustic miniatures with a head and a tail. The power of soilless performed songs like " When You Come to Me "and " Drink (Drink Drink)" lies in the simple beauty. If you did not know better, you would say that you can go for this music only in Texas.
