GUIDELINES

Look of Lyme is a new crowdsourcing media initiative to bring your personal stories of living with Lyme into the limelight. *What does your Lyme look like?*

Please follow these technical guidelines:

- Use the best quality camera you can; smart phone cameras are fine, but use the high-def setting 1080HD, if possible.
- Please limit your video to 5-10 minutes maximum.
- File size should be no larger than 7GB.
- Use horizontal orientation, not vertical (see diagram below).
- Make sure your subject fills the screen, and avoid too much "headroom" (see diagram below).
- Make the video as stable as possible; we recommend a tripod or unipod
- Unless you have separate microphones, keep the camera close to the subject for best sound.
- Before you begin, check the sound to make sure it is clear and audible.
- Don't film anyone who hasn't given you rights to appear publicly in your video.









Please follow these content guidelines by responding to the questions below:

- 1. What does your Lyme look like? Let the camera observe you. Show us how bad it gets.
- 2. Describe what was going on when you first realized something was wrong with your health.
- 3. How many doctors did you see and what kinds of things did they say?
- 4. What kinds of things were you (mis)diagnosed with?
- 5. Describe how and when you finally got a Lyme diagnosis.
- 6. How much out-of-pocket money have you spent on this journey?
- 7. Describe how it was when you hit rock bottom.
- 8. What is your greatest wish regarding the Lyme crisis?
- 9. What else would you like to show or tell the world?
