
Eight artists will be selected to produce a new body of work for the subsequent exhibition. The residency will take place in our open-plan project space, enabling the artists to interact and develop their practice in a stimulating and mutually supportive environment. There will be in-house critical feedback, and several opportunities for formal critique sessions with established artists and curators.

About Surface Gallery

Surface Gallery is the local contemporary art gallery of Nottingham.

We operate as a social enterprise, celebrating and supporting talent in our city, and engaging with our immediate community with a view to broadening participation in the arts. We are led by a co-operative team of early career professionals, who support each other in order to learn more about running a successful independent art gallery.

Located within Nottingham's burgeoning Creative Quarter, Surface Gallery's three-storey building welcomes visitors and exhibitors to its two gallery spaces, nine artist studios and open-plan office area.

THE PROJECT WILL INCLUDE

- A four-week artist residency at Surface Gallery: a high-quality, large and well-lit working space where artists will have free reign to develop new work.
- A two-week group exhibition at Surface Gallery following the end of the residency.
- Support and advice from the Surface Gallery team who will provide artistic and technical assistance throughout the residency.
- Networking and Q&A opportunities with the active artist community who work in the building.
- Promotion in Surface Gallery's newsletter and extensive social media network.
- 500 flyers distributed across the city to promote the exhibition.
- A potential small commission to help produce a new body of work during the residency. *
- Potential inclusion in a catalogue document the project. *
- Potential travel expenses. *

THE PROJECT WILL INVOLVE

- **Progress meetings** – selected artists will discuss the residency's progress and plan for their exhibition with the support of the Surface Gallery team.
- **Critique sessions** – held during the residency period. The selected artists will meet with established artists to receive feedback on their work.
- **Artist talks** – taking place during the exhibition and open to the public. Artists can discuss their practice and new work created for exhibition, with the support of Surface Gallery.
- **Workshops** – the opportunity to organise and run workshops with the local community
- **Development** – opportunities for one-to-one sessions with the Surface Team.
- **Curating** – gain invaluable experience by organising a group exhibition.
