## **Directions:**

## To Mount on Wall


- 1) Hold the sculpture up against the wall.
- 2) Place a sharp instrument through the holes in the base piece to mark their location on the wall.
- 3) Drill pilot holes. If the wall is sheet-rock or plaster use plastic anchors.
- 4) Screw the sculpture to the wall.

## To Wind


- 1) It is easiest to wind the sculpture if the sculpture wheels are still.
- 2) Hold the base piece behind the winding wheel with your right hand so that the sculpture orientation is similar to that pictured below.
- 3) Turn the winding wheel 20 turns counter-clockwise using the index finger of your left hand.

## To Start

The sculpture should start when you release the base after winding. If it doesn't, gently push the winding wheel base to start it swinging.
