

PURSUIT

Directions:

To Unpack:

- 1. Remove packing material and unscrew sculpture from packing backboard.
- Carefully untape and remove the cardboard covers and shipping spacers.
 Be careful not to damage the parchment paper under the cardboard covers.

To Mount on Wall:

- Hold the backboard in the desired location against the wall. Make sure the bottom edge of the backboard is level.
- Place a sharp instrument through the mounting screw holes marking their positions on the wall. The proper holes are labeled.
- Drill pilot holes. If the wall is plaster or sheet rock use plastic anchors.
- 4. Mount the sculpture using the two lower screws. When these are secured slide the colored fabric ring behind the base of the sculpture so the rim of the ring lines up with the rims on the wheels and the hole in the fabric coincides with the upper screw hole. The slot in the ring snaps around the base of the sculpture.
- 5. Screw the upper screw in place.

To Suspend Weight:

1. Pass the string from the spool located in front of the large pulley wheel under the pulley on the weight and loop it over the small metal hook on the lowest dowel.

To Start:

 Turn both large wheels in a clockwise direction.

To Wind:

 Turn the small wooden ring on the front of the sculpture counterclockwise until the weight is just below the sculpture.

To Stop:

Stop the motion of the large wheels.

Please save the shipping box and backboard to aid you when moving, storing or shipping your sculpture. The box can be colapsed for easy storage.
