

- 7 RULES FOR A SUCCESSFUL TRUNK HOST -

1. YOUR TRUNK: There are many ways to host a trunk. You can go all-out by decorating your trunk “to the nines” in a specific theme, hang lights and spider webs from your car, or simply bring your trunk “as is” and hand out candy with a smiling face. Hosting a trunk is not meant to be a stressful process. We encourage you to be as creative as you would like. (Please refrain from blood, gore, or death themed décor.)

2. CANDY: Our annual Trunk or Treat event is growing each year, and we estimate about 1,500 kids will take part in this year’s event. We ask that you provide as much candy as possible. We will be collecting donations to help support those that run out of candy before the event ends. Please only hand out **ONE** piece of candy per child. Some children will visit your trunk multiple times throughout the night and that is okay.

3. STAY AT YOUR TRUNK: At least one person must be stationed at your trunk at all times to pass out candy. **PLEASE STAY UNTIL THE EVENT ENDS AT 8:00 PM.** Leaving early can cause a dangerous situation for children.

4. BE ON TIME: Please arrive on the day of the event (October 25th) no later than 5:00 PM. Kids will start trunk or treating at 6:00 PM. We ask that you **DO NOT** hand out candy until 6:00 PM. Please try to arrive between 4:00PM and 5:00 PM. Please use the designated Trunk Host Entrance upon arrival. Signs will be posted to direct you.

5. TRUNK COMPETITION: All trunk hosts will be provided with a number to be placed in a visible location for voting as well as a trunk registration card. If you would like to be part of the contest, please fill out this card and return it to the Guest Services Booth in the Crossroads concourse. The competition categories are: “Best Trunk,” “Most Outrageous,” and “Kids Choice.” Good Luck!

6. BEHAVIOR: Even though this is an outdoor community-wide event, please refrain from smoking or drinking alcohol, and using harsh language. Please follow all posted signage.

7. HAVE FUN: This event is for you just as much as it is for the kids. Smile, relax, and enjoy your time at this
