## BFBC Worship Team Ministry Guidelines

- **Member of Bartlesville FBC** Being a member of the church is essential to being a part of the worship team... and not only a member, but a committed member. We ask that you attend services regularly, not just when you're scheduled to play on the team. It is highly encouraged that you also be a part of a small group, Sunday School, or both, as they are an important part of Christian growth and fellowship.
- **Maturity** This does not refer to age as much as it does a mature mindset. You must be able to receive critique and coaching from the leadership without taking it personally.
- **Time-** Being a part of the worship team requires a time commitment. We have rehearsal on Thursday nights at 7 pm. Remember that this rehearsal can easily last 2 hours, sometimes more. We ask that you arrive to church early on Sunday mornings to perform sound checks and any quick "run-through's" of the songs that may be necessary.
- **Musical expertise-** If you are a part of the band or vocals, it is essential that you exhibit your skill to the best of your ability. While it is not about perfection, it is important to remember Psalm 33:3 "Sing to him a new song; play *skillfully*, and shout for joy." Achieving this requires practice on your own. Our rehearsal nights are just that *-a rehearsal of what you have been practicing at home*.
- **Ability to flow with a team** While proficiency in your particular gift or talent is important, please note that your ability to play and flow with a team is highly desirable. Your attitude of worship and ability to blend with the group play a very important part in your consideration.

**Spiritual Maturity-** Being a part of the worship team is a leadership role. You are viewed as leaders and in that, you have a responsibility to live your life spiritually the same throughout the week as you do on Sunday. Remember, worship is not merely something that takes place on Sunday, but rather you should strive to live your life as a living sacrifice. Worship should be your lifestyle.

\*\*\*Upon receiving your information, we will contact you and set up a small interview (15 minutes). If you are interested in singing or being a part of the band, we will ask you to play or sing 2 contemporary worship songs that you are familiar with. If we feel that you're a good fit, we will then contact you at a later date to attend a practice and see how you flow with the band.
