

LATE NIGHT STUDY

TEAGUE LEARNING COMMONS

Sunday, Monday & Tuesday; May 6, 7, & 8

Hours: The Teague Learning Commons will remain open until 3:00 am on Sunday, Monday & Tuesday nights.

Who: Only current LBC students (residents & commuters) are welcome to stay past 12:00 midnight.

Things to Note:

1. Regular LBC handbook guidelines are in place.
2. All TLC guidelines will be in place.
3. A TLC student worker will be available if assistance is needed.
4. There will be Late Night Study monitors making rounds during the time.
5. The 5th level of the TLC will be closed at midnight and not available for use.
6. Your purpose for being in the TLC should be studying and/or working on projects for finals (not for hanging out, watching movies, etc.)
7. Students who are disruptive will be asked to leave and return to their dorms.
8. Each student must take responsibility to clean up his/her study area of food, wrappers, soda cans, and papers.
9. Regular campus curfew is in effect (1:00am). If not participating in Late Night Study, you are expected to be in your dorm (or off-campus if you are a commuter). It is not an "open campus" and the only place you may be is in the dorms and/or the TLC (food runs will need to be made prior to 1:00am and/or after 6:00am).
10. Housekeeping might be vacuuming during Late Night Study hours, so there might be additional noise at times.

Leaving the TLC:

1. If leaving after 1:00am, you are to go directly to your dorm (resident) or your car (commuter).
2. You do not need to stay in the TLC until 3:00am. You are able to return at any time to your dorm.
3. The TLC will close at 3:00am, and everyone will need to leave.
