

Subject Area	Autumn 2 Topic/ Focus Question Bonfire! (mini topic) Mrs Alford's Crafty Challenge
English	Poetry-Writing and performing senses poems based around the theme of 'Bonfire Night'. Narrative-Acting out, telling and re-writing versions of 'The First Christmas'. Non-Fiction-Following and writing instructions.
Maths	Children will be working on the following key areas: Addition and subtraction— partitioning numbers into tens and units and using practical equipment, to make adding and subtracting easier. Solving problems. Measuring lengths using non-standard measures (cubes etc) and moving on to centimetres and metres.
Topic	Linked Questions/areas of work <u>Bonfire!</u> Short study into history of Bonfire Night and how it is remembered every year. Art projects.
Science / History/ Geography	<u>Mrs Alford's Crafty Challenge!</u> Mrs Alford visits the children and challenges them to hold a Christmas Craft Fair. She gives them a budget and tells them that any profit made can be spent on their classrooms. They can choose what they spend their profit on! The children are visited from a representative from a local factory and learn about health and safety and production. The children design, cost and make items for the craft fair (carrying out market research in the first instance) and then advertise and manage their craft fair.
