### Welcome

A warm welcome back to everyone after our summer holidays. We are delighted to welcome many new families and also to share very exciting times with our existing families as your children embark on the next step in their time at Carr Hill. The children are beginning to get to know the different staff and routines already.

### Topic work

Both the full time and Nursery children are starting their Autumn term with work about the story Elmer by David McKee. The way we work is that we start with the same starting point but then we plan our activities based on the interests of the children in the classes and allow them to help in the direction we will take our teaching and learning. This means that, although we start with the same theme, we will undoubtedly end up learning about slightly different things that **have captured the children's imagination. We will be posting pictures and observations of your children as they are learning on Tapestry.** A few parents have not yet activated their account, please see a member of staff if you are having trouble doing so. **Don't forget that you can add comment or pictures yourself.** We love to see how the children are continuing their learning at home.
