

Subject Area	Autumn 2  <b>Topic/ Focus Question</b>  Christmas is Coming!
English	Poetry-Writing and performing senses poems based around the theme of 'Bonfire Night'.  Narrative-Acting out, telling and re-writing versions of different Santa Stories.
Maths	Children will be working on the following key areas:  Addition and subtraction— partitioning numbers into tens and units and using practical equipment, to make adding and subtracting easier. Solving problems.  Shape & Money
Topic	<b>Linked Questions/areas of work</b> <u>Christmas is Coming!</u>  Mrs Alford visits the children and challenges them to hold a Christmas Craft Fair. She gives them a budget and tells them that any profit made can be spent on their classrooms. They can choose what they spend their profit on! The children design, cost and make items for the craft fair (carrying out market research in the first instance) and then advertise and manage their craft fair.
