STOP #3 - LEVITICUS: GOD LIVES WITH HOLY PEOPLE
TEXT: LEVITICUS 17:11; 19:2, 18

1. Have you ever read through the book of *Leviticus*? If you started, but didn't finish, what kept you from making it through to the end? Skim *Leviticus 1-5* and name the five offerings listed.
2. What is the premier attribute of God in the book of *Leviticus* (*Leviticus 11:44-45; 19:2; 20:26*)? What does this word even mean and why is it important when we think about God (*Isaiah 6:3*)?
3. Fill in the blanks: "Be _____ for I the Lord your God am _____" (*Leviticus 19:2*). This is the key sentence of *Leviticus*. What application does this verse have for us today (*1 Peter 1:15-16*)?
4. *Exodus* concludes with a holy God descending to make His home with His chosen people (*Exodus 40:34-38*). Immediately He gave them *Leviticus*. Can you guess why (*Leviticus 26:11-12*)?
5. What does the tragic story of Nadab and Abihu tell us (*Leviticus 10*)? Initially, their offense does not seem that severe, but why should we understand their consequence to be just?
6. Holiness seems impossible for us today. What is God's remarkable promise (*Leviticus 21:15, 23; 22:9, 16*)? What is one thing we must do if we are to become holy (*Leviticus 5:1-6; Psalm 32:5*)?
7. Read *1 John 1:5-9*. What connections do you see between these verses and the book of *Leviticus*? In light of our study of *Leviticus*, how is God challenging you to grow (*Ephesians 4:1*)?
