Core Truths:

*People are quick to forget the faithfulness of God, so we need visual aids and frequent reminders to keep us in an attitude of gratitude..

*In the Tabernacle you come to God, God's way. God's way is through the shedding of the blood of the innocent on behalf of the guilty.

*Each part of the earthly Tabernacle pointed to a heavenly reality.

*Jesus beautifully fulfills every aspect of the Tabernacle and is the ONE it points to!

Table Talk:

1. God's desire was to fellowship with His people Israel and He went to great lengths to do that. He also went to great lengths to fellowship with us. What lengths did He go to with Israel? What lengths did He go to with us? What should we do in response?
2. The curtains surrounding the courtyard were a boundary, when a person entered through the gate they knew they were coming to God, God's way. What happened when they did not come to God in an acceptable way? Why was this so grievous to God?
3. On this side of Calvary we see the symbolism of the Tabernacle and Jesus' fulfillment of it. What have you understood for the first time today about the Tabernacle, Jesus or yourself, as a believer? What do you need to do with that new knowledge?
4. Each piece of furniture in the entire Tabernacle had a specific purpose. Which piece holds the most meaning for you and why?
5. What does it look like for you personally and spiritually to offer your body as a living sacrifice to God? (Rom. 12:1&2)
