



## CONSIGNMENT PROGRAM

Authors who are self-published, or who are published by presses without wide distribution, may apply to have their book sold at The Writer's Block on a consignment basis. Consignment books remain the author's property, and any unsold copies are returned at the end of the consignment period.

Consignment at The Writer's Block lasts for only one month, but includes an opportunity to participate in an author meet-and-greet and signing on the final Saturday evening of the month. There are no fees for consignment, and the profits from sold books are split 80/20%, with 80% going directly to the author.

## HOW IT WORKS

- Authors can bring or mail their consignment requests (see page 2 of this document), along with one copy of their book, to the following address:

There are no fees for consignment requests. However, we are not able to mail your book back to you.

- Our staff will review your book. This process takes 1–2 weeks. **You will be notified by email of our decision.** All decisions are final and non-negotiable, and occur at the sole discretion of The Writer's Block staff. In the event that we decline to carry your book on consignment, your book will be held for two months for you to pick up. If you do not come for your book within two months, it will be donated or destroyed.

- If your book is approved, we will slot you into our consignment calendar. All consignment titles are carried for a period of one month, and a maximum of five titles are selected for each consignment cycle. If a particular month is convenient for you, we will gladly take that into consideration.

- We will begin selling your book on the first day of your scheduled month. It is your responsibility to either bring or ship a minimum of five, and a maximum of ten, copies of your book. If we are close to selling out, we will notify you and request more.

- On the final Saturday of the month, you and all other authors whose titles have been available on consignment will be invited to participate in a meet-and-greet and signing. This signing will be the culmination of the consignment period, and at the end we will cut you a check in person for any books that have been sold and return unsold copies to you. If you cannot participate in the event, it will be your responsibility to pick up any unsold copies and your check. **We cannot ship your books or your check, and unclaimed books will be donated or destroyed after two months.**

1. a valid, 13-digit ISBN
2. a barcode
3. a clearly printed title and author
4. paperback, stitched or hardcover binding; spiral-bound books cannot be accepted
