**AN ORDER OF HEALING** is offered at the conclusion of the liturgy of the Holy Eucharist on the first Sunday of each month.

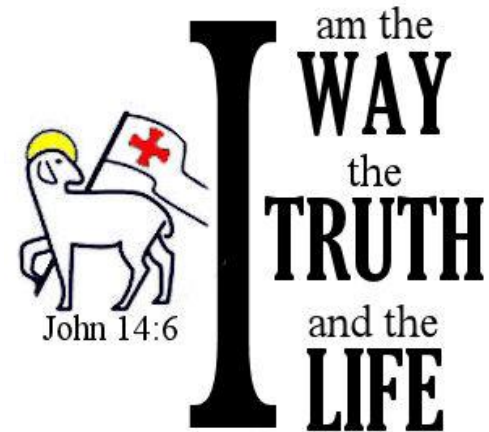
