

## **ORDER**

UPON THIS MOTION EX-PARTE dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January and filed the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January 2020 praying this Honourable Court for the following Orders:

- 1. AN ORDER OF INTERIM INJUCTION restraining the Respondents whether by themselves or through their agents, Servants, privies or otherwise, from demolishing any of the Applicants' and others' homes, business premises, properties or community facilities in Island communities across Lagos or evicting the Applicants or others therefrom pending the hearing of the Motion on Notice and/or the conclusion of the substantive suit.
- 2. AN ORDER OF INTERIM INJUNCTION restraining the Respondents themselves or through their agents, servants, privies or otherwise, from harassing the 1<sup>st</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> Applicants and other unlawfully evicted residents of Okun Ayo or Tarkwa Bay communities with shooting of guns, other



violent attacks, threats of arrest or arrest of persons for simply being in the community pending the hearing of the Motion on Notice the hearing of the substantive suit.

- 3. AN ORDER OF MANDATORY INJUNCTION requiring the Respondents to immediately provide the 1<sup>st</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> Applicants and other unlawfully evicted residents of Okun ayo. Tarkwa Bay community with relief materials and emergency shelter and to rebuild their unlawfully demolished homes, business premises, properties, and community facilities at the soonest possible moment.
- AND for such further Order or Orders as this Honourable Court may deem fit to make in the circumstances.

AND AFTER READING the affidavit in support of Motion Ex-sworn to by Chief F. O. Maxwell, Male, Christian, Adult, Nigerian, a Sailor and Baale of Tarkwa Bay, of Baale's Palace, Tarkwe Bay Community, Eti-Osa LGA, Lagos State, filed in this Court Registry, Ikoyi, Lagos.



## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That an Order of Interim Injunction is granted restraining the Respondents whether by themselves or through their agents, Servants, privies or otherwise, from demolishing any of the Applicants' and others' homes, business premises, properties or community facilities in Island communities across Lagos or evicting the Applicants or others therefrom pending the hearing of the Motion on Notice and/or the conclusion of the substantive suit.
- 2. That an Order of Interim Injunction is granted restraining the Respondents themselves or through their agents, servants, privies or otherwise, from harassing the 1<sup>st</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> Applicants and other unlawfully evicted residents of Okun Ayo or Tarkwa Bay communities with shooting of guns, other violent attacks, threats of arrest or arrest of persons for simply being in the community pending the hearing of the Motion on Notice the hearing of the substantive suit.
- 3. That only the above 2 prayers (1 and 2) of the Interim application are granted pending the hearing of the Motion on Notice when the Respondents shall show cause.



- 4. That the Interlocutory Order of Injunction cannot be made until the hearing of the substantive fundamental Right Applicant.
- Interlocutory 5. That the Motion for Injunction/or substantive application shall be heard on the 13th day of February 2020
