OUR STORY THE HISTORY OF VINTAGE CHURCH

Our story began in the Spring of 2012 as God began to call our senior pastor and his wife to plant a church in the Fort Hood area. Less than 12 months later, they would relocate their family to Harker Heights, deploy a strategic plan, raise funds and start building a launch team.

On January 19, 2014, with the help of his pastor and a spiritual family of churches, we launched our first public worship service in a Cinemark movie theater. Over 380 people attended that inaugural service.

What started as a vision in the hearts of our leaders grew from a humble 14 people meeting in a living room to a congregation that over 1,400 people call home.

Vintage Church has a specific call to the military & the communities that serve them.

It is our dedication to the mission that motivates us to create environments where ordinary people can experience spiritual family and be equipped to love God and love their neighbors as themselves.

We are excited about what God continues to do in our church family and we are convinced that the best is yet to come.

What are messages like?


