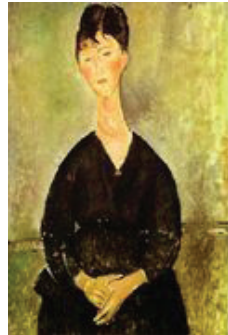
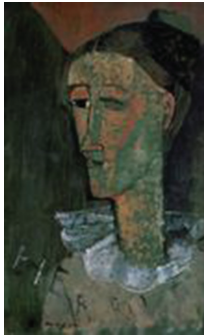

Join Stephen Ackert in a discussion on the music of Joseph Maurice Ravel and the art of Amedeo Clemente Modigliani. Learn how both artists defied convention and rebelled against the musical and artistic establishments of the early 20th century.



*This lecture will feature images of Modigliani paintings, including **Nude on a Blue Cushion** (1917), **Self-Portrait as Pierrot** (1915), **Café Singer** (1917), and **Study for the Cellist** (1909) and late 20th- and early 21st-century music inspired by him.*
