This came from the STATE -

“Due to construction at McNeil High School we have very limited parking at the RRISD Raymond E. Hartfield Performing Arts Center until after 5:00 PM each school day.

The parking lot behind the PAC (on the North side) is used for staff/student parking each day until after school is out. Classes dismiss at 4:20 PM so between 4:00 PM and 5:00 PM traffic is very congested getting in and out of the PAC. After 5:00 PM parking should not be an issue for our guests.

We have arranged for UIL guests to park at Gateway Church , if there is no parking available or the lots are full, which is 2.1 miles on McNeil Drive. (a map is attached).

Buses/trucks that bring students and equipment will need to park at Gateway from 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

The YMCA or Crosspointe Church across from the Performing Arts Center tow so we do not advise using these parking lots.”
