Purpose: Design volunteers are responsible for helping to design posters for LSPIRG events and campaigns, outreach materials, displays, etc.

Location: LSPIRG office, 165 Albert St., 3rd Floor

Key Responsibilities:

- Assisting the Communications & Community Director with design work using Adobe Creative Suites, specifically InDesign
- Designing posters, campaign materials, and outreach materials

Reports to: Volunteer Engagement Director

Time Commitment: 5-10 hours per week

Qualifications: Strong knowledge of Adobe Creative Suite or willingness to learn quickly, experience with Photoshop, CorelDRAW, SerifDRAW, or InDesign considered an asset, creativity, teamwork, attention to detail, ability to meet deadlines

Support: All volunteers receive orientation including anti-oppression training. Design volunteers will also receive a briefing on LSPIRG's style guide and will have access to further training on software when needed.

*Please note: LSPIRG can accommodate up to two design volunteers per semester. If more than two students apply, an interview process will determine which candidates are successful.
