Purpose: The PIRGER is LSPIRG's monthly zine, covering topics of social justice, environment, and community. Volunteers are responsible for the production and management of distribution of this zine from start to finish.

Location: LSPIRG office

Key Responsibilities:

- Writing and seeking out/ securing content from a variety of sources
- Keeping up on LSPIRG events and campaigns to include in the zine
- Editing submissions
- Working collaboratively with LSPIRG staff on layout of the zine
- Printing, folding, and managing distribution

Reports to: Volunteer Engagement Director

Time Commitment: 5-10 hours per week in the LSPIRG office for at least one semester, extension of position to a second semester may be negotiated

Qualifications: Must be prepared to work as part of a team of two co-editors, excellent written and oral communication skills, time management, leadership experience

Support: All volunteers receive orientation including anti-oppression training. PIRGER volunteers will receive back-issues of the PIRGER and will receive continuous support from LSPIRG staff.

*Please note: LSPIRG can accommodate up to two PIRGER volunteers per semester. If we receive more than two applicants, an interview process will determine best candidates for the position.
