

Free Amigurumi Jiggly Puff Pattern

DESCRIPTION:

Jiggly Puff is a feisty, cute little Pokémon. Here we have her as a small amigurumi keychain that stands 2 ½ inches tall. With her arms spread, she is almost 3 inches wide.

This is an easy to medium difficulty pattern. Skills needed: sc, hdc, dc, increase and decrease, magic loop, fasten off, and basic sewing.

SUPPLIES:



- Fiberfill
- Acrylic yarn in pink (pastel or light pink)
- Sewing needle for stitching
- Black yarn for the mouth
- Crochet hook (E- 3.5mm) (I used this
- Plastic safety eyes, or you may use felt. I used bigger eyes here- 12mm
- Black felt



- Scissors and textile glue (or super glue)
- (If you're new to crocheting, I recommending getting a crochet set.)



INSTRUCTIONS:

Head/Body- (Note that 2 sc in each sc = INCREASE)

- Round (Rnd) 1: 6 sc in magic loop (magic ring), 6 stitches (6 st)
- Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around (12)
- Rnd 3: 2 sc in next sc, sc in the next sc* rep 6 times (that's all around) (18)
- Rnd 4: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc* rep 6 times (24)
- Rnd 5: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc* rep 6 times (30)
- Rnd 6: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc* rep 6 times (36) (notice we are increasing six st with each round)
- Rnd 7: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc* rep 6 times (42)
- Rnd 8: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc* rep 6 times (48)
- Rnd 9-12: sc in each sc around (48) this is the middle portion
- Between rounds 9-10, I put in the plastic safety eyes, around 7 stitches apart
- Rnd 13: sc2tog (decrease), sc in next 6 sc* rep 6 times (42)
- Rnd 14: sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc* rep 6 times (36)
- Rnd 15: sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc* rep 6 times (30)
- Rnd 16: sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc* rep 6 times (24)
- Rnd 17: sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc* rep 6 times (18)
- Rnd 18: sc2tog, sc in next sc* rep 6 (12)
- Rnd 19: sc2tog* rep 6 (6)
- Fasten off (f/o) leaving long tail for sewing close. Stuff ball with fiberfill, stuff more for a firmer and rounder ball shape, and less for softer. Sew the end close.



Arms (make 2)

- Rnd 1: 3 sc in magic loop (3)
- Rnd 2-3: sc in next sc (3)
- Rnd 4: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc (4)
- Rnd 5: sc in next sc (4)
- F/o, leave long tail to sew to body. Stuff with a little fiberfill if you'd like to, although not really needed.

Feet (make 2)

- Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic loop (6)
- Rnd 2: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc (7)
- Rnd 3-4: sc in next sc (7)
- F/o, leave long tail to sew to body. You may stuff with a tiny amount of fiberfill, but not really needed. If you want bigger or smaller feet, just adjust with the initial sc in the magic loop and increase accordingly.

"Hair" Curl

- Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic loop (6)
- Rnd 2-4: sc in next sc (6)
- Rnd 5: 2 sc in next sc around (12)
- Rnd 6: sc in next sc around (12)
- Rnd 7: sc in next 8 sc, turn (8)
- Rnd 8: sc in next 7 sc, turn (7)
- Rnd 9; sc in next 6 sc (6)
- F/o off, leave long tail to sew to head. Stuff the curl and twist for curl effect.

<u>Keychain loop:</u> It's just a string of yarn (any color). Loop the string through top of head and tie a knot.





Mouth

You can use black yarn to stitch a mouth, or black felt. You can be creative with the expression. Jiggly Puff is often agitated or upset, so a frown may look cute too!

Ears (make 2)

- Rnd 1: 4 sc in magic loop (4) (leave a long hanging tail for sewing)
- Rnd 2: hdc in next 3 sc, dc in next sc (4)
- F/o and sew using the long hanging tail to the head. Cut a small triangle with the black felt and glue onto the ear. Sew the bottom wider part to the head.
