

Vaccination Policy

As a Christian charity providing international health care, Medical Ministry International values the use of vaccinations to protect all people, especially the most vulnerable. Many vaccines are used to protect our communities from conditions such as diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, meningococcal disease, whooping cough (pertussis), chickenpox, influenza, and COVID-19.

Medical Ministry International strongly recommends that all employees, contractors, volunteers, and project team participants, whether in North America, at an international program location, or elsewhere in the world be fully up to date on all vaccinations.

In the case of international project team participants, it is the responsibility of the participant to determine what vaccination or testing requirements are in place in the participant's country of origin, country of destination, and any in-transit locations prior to booking travel.

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
