In this course we will look at news articles and short videos from around the francophone world, examine topics such as politics, the arts, technology, the environment, and sports as they emerge in the news. Understanding of the passé composé, futur and imparfait required. This course is not designed as a comprehensive lecture series, but rather as a survey class and a starting point for lively class discussions.</p>
