

# A Tour Thru Tuscany Wine Tasting

Saturday, December 9<sup>th</sup>, Noon-3pm

## Ferghettina Franciacorta Brut Milledì

Straw yellow, with gold and green reflections and tiny, persistent perlage. On the palate, elegant notes of citrus fruit and a minerally freshness; a long finish.

## Falchini 2015 Ab Vinea Doni (Vernaccia di San Gimignano)

Aromas of yellow pear, Spanish broom and a whiff of honeyed nut float from the glass. The medium-bodied palate shows good weight and depth for the cool wet vintage, offering golden apple, nectarine zest and bitter almond framed in vibrant acidity.

## Vignamaggio Gherardino, Chianti Classico DOCG, 2013

A blend of Sangiovese and 15% Merlot, this round, medium-bodied wine offers aromas of dark berry, blue flowers and a whiff of cedar. The friendly, accessible palate delivers juicy black cherry, tobacco and a hint of licorice alongside soft tannins and bright acidity.

## Caprili Rosso di Montalcino 2015

Beautiful light red. Nose of red fruits with fairly pronounced smoke undertones. On the palate, a very honest, light wine with the fruit character carrying through coupled with smoky and mineral notes.

## Tenuta Tre Rose Vino Nobile di Montepulciano DOCG, 2013

The Noble Wine of Montepulciano St. Catherine of Tre Rose presents an intense grenade red color. Its scent is complex, with a plum aroma that blends with spicy notes, particularly coffee, and a scent of fresh boisé. In the mouth it is full and elegant, with a good presence of tannins.

## Brunello di Montalcino DOCG Nastagio, 2012

Full bodied, intense and elegant with hints of ripe red fruits well balanced with spices and vanilla aromas contributed by the barrels during the ageing. Very good structure, the tannins are ripe and persistent perfectly combined with the bright freshness of Sangiovese.

## Mazzei Tenuta Belguardo Maremma, 2010

Made with Cabernet Sauvignon and a small percentage of Cabernet Franc grapes, this powerful and elegant wine is the most important "Cru" of the Estate, the maximum expression of its native exceptional "terroir".

## Casale Falchini Podere Casale 1 Vin Santo del Chianti, 2010

Light amber with gold flecks. A muted elegant orange peel and toffee nose. The palate offers up orange flesh, candied orange, burnt marmalade, medium/high sweetness.
