St. John's now has a Hearing Loop Hearing Loops allow people who wear hearing aids to directly receive the sound from the church's PA system in their own hearing aids without having to pick up a separate listening device. The hearing loop system at St. John's enables parishioners with hearing loss to participate fully in the services.
