Collins grew up on a ranch in Phoenix, attended both Arizona State University and the University of Arizona, worked 20 years for the Centers for Disease Control in Central America and Mexico, and is now a rancher in Southern Arizona. Between 2008 and 2012, he retraced Jesuit missionary Eusebio Kino's 17th- and 18th-century travels in Sonora and Arizona with a group of like-minded ranchers. Collins lays out his opinions, ideas and experiences in clear, solid prose. He doesn't have solutions to our ongoing conflicts, but his thoughts are worth any border dweller's time.
