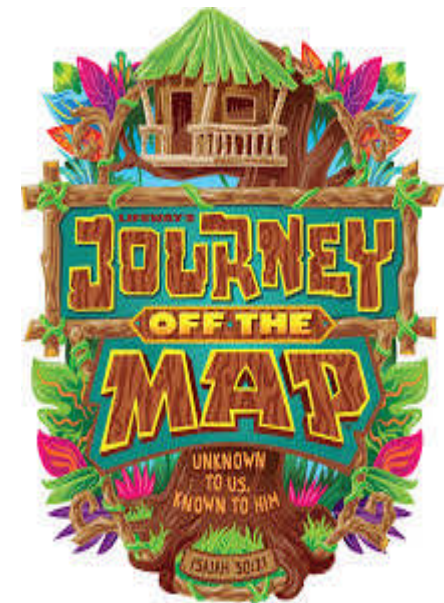

## From the Desk of Andy Jung...

Here is the understatement of the year: Our culture has changed over time. We do not have to think very hard to make a list of all of the things that have changed over the past 50-60 years. Advancements in technology have pushed us into a quicker pace of life. We are much more mobile as a society which has caused us to be less connected to a community. No matter how much we want to hold on to the ideal of "Mayberry," it is in the days of the past.

Society's church culture has also changed over time. We no longer live in a time when people come to church just because the doors are open. There has been a great deal of talk over the latest research findings by Pew Research that only confirmed what we already sensed...that we now live in a post-Christian culture. (I will write more about this in the upcoming weeks.) However, many of us remain nostalgic about the church culture of the past. Many of us yearn for the simpler times and how we "felt" when we were together at church. Even though we really cannot go back to (nor should we really want to) the ways of the past, we can experience snippets of it every once in a while. That is what we want to try to re-create during the month of July.

We will try to reach back and create the nostalgic feel of a gospel revival during worship. Though it will happen in snippets, we hope to create a slightly more relaxed environment during worship. We will sing the "good ole gospel hymns" and hear some testimonies of how God changed people's lives.
