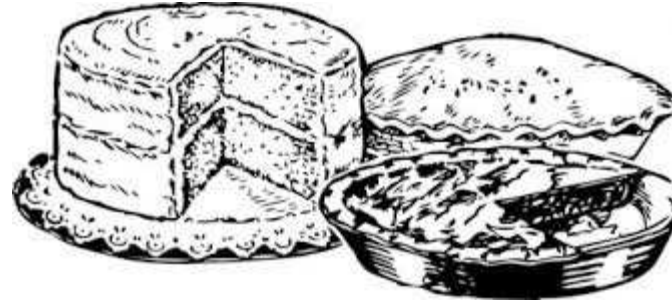

## **From the Desk of Andy Jung...**

A small team of FBC members (Lois Hinson, Bob & Olivia Sweet, Reta Thompson and Andy Jung) is traveling to Roatan, Honduras in partnership with Live Again Ministries for an 8-day mission experience this Saturday. The mission team will mainly serve the aging population on the island with a special festival. With any additional time, we will visit small villages to share the love of Jesus with the children and families who are open to the Gospel.

Though Roatan is a beautiful Caribbean island filled with significant tourism, most of its citizens live on approximately \$1 per day. The residents have limited access to clean water and consistent electricity. Public education ends at 6<sup>th</sup> grade for most and preventable sicknesses run rampant on the island, mainly from lack of sanitation and clean water. Outside of the tourist area, the locals often live in poverty.

By partnering with Live Again Ministries of Locust, we are able to participate in ongoing ministries that will have lasting impact on the tiny island. Live Again Ministries take local groups to Roatan 4-5 times a year to install clean water filtration systems in small villages. In addition, the ministry builds relationships with the village leaders and other officials who can help make systemic changes to better the lives of the Roatan people.

I am excited about the opportunities our team will have to make an impact for the Kingdom of God. We want to thank everyone who brought washcloths and t-shirts for us to share with the Roatan people. Thank you to those who also donated financially. The team would covet your prayers as we travel and work in some difficult areas. Pray for our health and for us to be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit. We will have an opportunity to share our experiences during worship on May 22.

This Sunday, Rev. Michael Furr will continue our series on Sticky Faith by focusing on God's instructions on how we are to pass on our faith to the next generation. In addition, the Spaghetti Lunch and Dessert Auction will
