As I was sitting in worship at Oak Ridge Chapel of Roatan, Honduras, I saw a beautiful picture of what a Sticky Faith church looks like. As we were sitting under the teaching of one of the matriarchs of the church during Sunday School, a young mother was struggling to keep her young child from causing too much distraction. Soon, I noticed one of the other ladies of the church offer to take the child from the mother to give her a break. As she was taking the child to the back of the sanctuary, Bob Sweet reached out his hands and gently offered to take the little girl into his arms. The lady seemed to be caught off guard for a moment but handed the girl over to Bob. For the next 15 minutes, the girl sat on Bob's lap and played with a wristband. They often stared into each other's eyes and a love affair was born.

After the worship service, I once again found the little girl in Bob's arms with the girl's parents off in the distance. The girl seemed content and there was no doubt she had Bob wrapped around her finger. Trust was displayed by the parents for simply handing over their child to be cared for by a stranger from a foreign land. It was a beautiful moment of how the church is a family of families, even beyond the borders of a nation and the boundaries of common language. I was reminded of the true meaning of the body of Christ.
