From the Desk of Andy Jung...

One of the goals I've personally had for our church has been to develop a stronger tie with the students at Pfeiffer University. Even though we are just far enough away to "attract" a large group of Pfeiffer students, I've always believed that we were capable of reaching students and providing a church home while they are away from home.

During this transition process of searching for our next Associate Pastor of Family Ministries, we have made a stronger connection with some of the students at Pfeiffer University out of necessity. This Sunday, we will have the privilege of ordaining two deacons, Jane Myers and Daniel Brown. We will lay hands on our new deacons and set them apart for the work of our ministry together.
