Words From the Pastor

Over the past 19 years of full-time ministry, I've witnessed a lot of music ministers in action. They have all been talented in their own right and successful in leading people to the foot of the cross on a weekly basis in worship. Each of them is gifted musically and uses their gifts for the Kingdom. Yet, I can state without hesitation that Aza Hudson stands out above the ones that I have known over the years. You don't need me to tell you that because you see it on a weekly basis. However, as we celebrate her 10th anniversary of being the Director of Music Programming at Frist Baptist, allow me to recount what a blessing she is to our congregation.



First, she is incredibly talented. Not only is she gifted musically but she is also talented in working with people. We should not overlook the latter. In congregational ministry, there is a fine line to walk of leading the people to higher heights and leaving people behind along the way. It is a privilege to serve alongside Aza, who is so dedicated to her ministry. I hope you will let her know how much you appreciate her and her ministry as we celebrate her 10th anniversary.
