Words From the Pastor

Learning to see the world through the lens of Jesus is not an easy thing to accomplish. Yet, if we train our hearts and minds, then we can get better at seeing the world through the eyes of Jesus. God's kingdom is among us. It is just up to us to seek it with all of ourselves.

This year's Winter Bible Study will help us to discern God's kingdom in the area of film and culture. While some Christians consider it their sacred duty to protest the content produced in Hollywood, others see films as harmless fun, unworthy of serious thought. Unfortunately, both attitudes risk missing God's grace in unexpected places. Dr. Cameron Jorgenson, Associate Professor of Christian Theology and Ethics at Campbell University Divinity School, will lead our discussion about how we can discover God at work in the ordinary places we gather. This year's study is called "Film, Faith and Food."



Dr. Jorgenson will begin the study during the morning worship on Sunday, February 11 with his sermon "Amazing Grace in Unexpected Places." He will continue the study that afternoon/evening from 4:00-7:30 with a presentation titled "Faith and Film: Encountering 'Reel' Spirituality." He will then conclude the Winter Bible Study the following Sunday (Feb. 18, 4:00-7:30) with a viewing of the Oscar-winning film, *Babette's Feast* and a critical discussion.

I hope that you will plan on being a part of this year's special discipleship study. As followers of Jesus, our goal is to faithfully walk with him in all aspects of life. This year's study will help us exegete an aspect of our culture we often overlook.

This Sunday will be a wonderful day of worship, fellowship and missions. We continue our series on *Transformational Teachings of Jesus* as we take a closer look at one of Jesus' great parables. We will dive deeper into Luke 14:16-24 to see how we are called to share our lives with those who may not be able to reciprocate. In addition, we will put what we learn into action by having the opportunity to participate in Souper Bowl of Caring. Be sure to make plans to join others at the soup and sandwich luncheon immediately following worship to raise funds for the Backpack Buddies Ministry at East Albemarle Elementary. We will also honor Tony Perryman who graduated early from North Stanly High School. See you on Sunday!

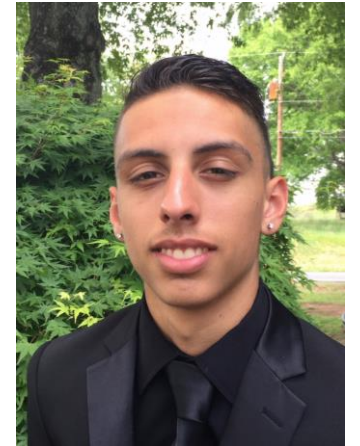

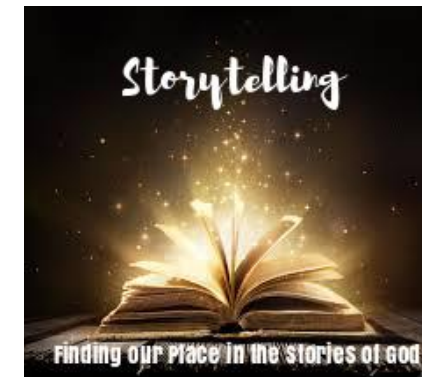
