## Words From the Pastor

This weekend, we celebrate the “unofficial” beginning of the summer with the observance of Memorial Day. Yet, we want to make sure we properly remember the true meaning of the holiday. We pause to remember those who have sacrificed their lives for our freedoms we enjoy daily. It is an important day in the life of our nation as we remember the men and women who died while serving our nation.

Many cities around the country have worked hard to honor our veterans, especially the World War II veterans from the Greatest Generation. Since 2005, HonorAir and the National Honor Flight programs have been responsible for flying over 150,000 WWII veterans to our nation’s capital to experience their memorial in Washington D.C. Charlotte’s Queen City Honor Flight is part of this special network.

The next Queen City Honor Flight will depart from Charlotte Douglas Airport this Saturday, May 26 with three of our own veterans. Bill Rogers and Leon Frederick will be honored guests on the Honor Flight as World War II veterans. These two men served in our armed forces faithfully and honorably during WWII along with several others in our church. These two men will be joined by Robert Stonestreet (retired general) who will serve as one of the guardians for the flight. These men will visit the memorials dedicated to their service and sacrifices.

If you would like to “welcome home” these veterans from their trip, guests are invited to the celebration at CLT airport. Guests are advised to arrive at the airport on Saturday around 7pm to go through airport security and stake out a spot along the parade route in the D concourse. The veterans are expected to return between 9:00-9:30pm.

As a first-generation immigrant to this great nation, I am grateful for all of our veterans, especially to those who paid the ultimate price. Their service and sacrifice do not go unnoticed. On this Memorial Day, let us take a few moments to remember those who gave their lives for our country and the families who remain. Let us also give thanks to those who served alongside those brave men and women. Let us also pray for the those who are currently serving in our military and defending the freedoms of our nation and other nations all over the world.

This Sunday, we will worship our God as we remember the might and power of God’s voice as David writes in Psalm 29. If you are in town this weekend, join us for worship. See you on Sunday.
