Words From the Pastor

Over the last year, we have supported three missionaries who are connected to our fellowship through prayer and financial support: Rob & Amanda Rone, Molly Peele and John Taylor. Let me give you an update on each of these missionaries who are working to build God's kingdom in their respective places.

Rob & Amanda Rone are missionaries in Pyin Oo Lwin, Myanmar. The couple has started a school for adults to teach English in the city to financially support themselves as they learn Burmese. They have quickly grown the number of classes they offer and now have over 100 regular students in six weekday classes and two Saturday classes. Many of the students are young people who are seeking to learn English for future jobs. The Rones are building relationships with their students and with the people in the community as they shine the light of Jesus through their words, actions and attitudes. Through your prayers and support, this young couple is making a difference on the other side of the world.

This past Sunday, we heard from Molly Peele who is serving as a home missionary through SBC's North America Mission Board on the campus of Johnson and Wales University in Rhode Island. Along with other missionaries, Molly has worked to build meaningful relationships with students on campus and connecting them to local churches for community and spiritual development. Over the past year, she has met with college students, led Bible studies and served alongside students who are learning what it means to be a follower of Jesus. At the end of June, she plans on returning to Rhode Island to continue her ministry for another year. Your prayers and support have been felt in her ministry.

Finally, John Taylor has been serving as a missionary through Campus Crusade for Christ in a closed country in the Far East for the past year. John is scheduled to be home in July but is planning to return for another year of ministry in the same location. Like Molly, he has spent the year developing relationships with young people who are curious about Jesus and the Bible. He has led Bible studies in small groups and attended church in homes. As always in a closed country, John has had to be discreet about his mission but has experienced the presence of Christ in wonderful ways.

I am so proud to be a part of a church that believes in missions and supports those who have been called to go in His name. Each of our missionaries still need your prayers and financial support. If you would like to give through the church to specifically support a missionary, please be sure to note that on your gift by placing the name(s). The church will send the money to the appropriate organizations.
