Words From the Pastor

Each year around November, First Baptist has participated in Samaritan Purse's Operation Christmas Child. We have filled boxes with toys, school supplies and other items to send to children all over the world who are not fortunate enough to have them. Many of you have put boxes together and have sent them filled with your love. Last year, you helped to donate over 500 boxes!

Yuliya Shubina received a shoebox gift in Central Asia that connected her to a caring friend halfway around the world and was one of the seeds that brought her to faith in Christ. Yuliya's father brought her a shoebox gift from missionaries who were distributing the gifts to local children. There were many gifts inside, including a letter from the girl who had packed the shoebox. Yuliya and the girl exchanged letters for many years afterward, and when Yuliya came to the United States to finish high school, she was able to meet her pen pal in person. Today, Yuliya serves with Operation Christmas Child to tell the story of God's faithfulness in her life.

On Sunday, July 15, Yuliya will be our guest speaker in worship. It is difficult to get on the schedule through Samaritan's Purse for someone like Yuliya who received a box and is now in the United States sharing about how God used the gift of a shoebox for the kingdom. Many thanks to Olivia Sweet for spearheading this effort.

As a way of showing appreciation for Yuliya coming to First Baptist to share her testimony, we will collect a special love offering at the end of worship to support the cost of shipping of Operation Christmas Child boxes. If you would like to give, checks should be made out to First Baptist Church with "OCC" on the memo line.

I am looking forward to hearing Yuliya's story and learning how God has revealed his love and faithfulness to her over the years. It will be a great reminder of God's sovereignty and love.

This year, our goal for OCC will be to collect over 600 boxes. Plans have long been in motion to reach this goal. Over 300 dresses have already been made to put in the boxes for girls. Soccer balls and pumps have been purchased for the boy boxes. Stuffed animals and other supplies have been procured. In the next few weeks, you will begin seeing displays and bulletin boards asking for donations of school supplies. We encourage you to take advantage of "Back-to-School" sales that will be happening in stores soon. Our annual "Packing party" will be on Wednesday, September 19 at 6pm. Thank you for sharing in the vision to reach the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

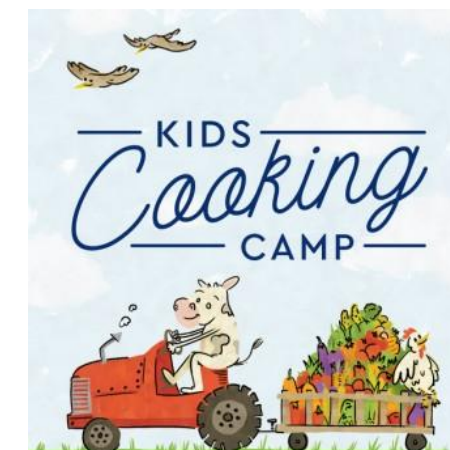
