Words From the Pastor

Sometimes, our spiritual lives and our actual lives can become two separate entities. We fall into the rut of coming to church, going to Sunday School, sitting through worship and we go home. Our cultivation of spiritual lives stops as we walk out the doors of the church on Sunday morning until the following week. Too often, we get stuck in this cycle. I don't think that is what God had in mind.

God desires for us to live life to the full. God's vision for your life is not just that you are saved by grace, but that you also learn to live by grace. God desires for you to see yourself as a saint (a person who is being sanctified by God) and live into that identity. There is more to life than going to school or advancing your career. The abundant life is best experienced

through healthy relationships with God and with the people around us. This is why we have been talking about *The Life I Want to Live* this summer.



Over the last six weeks, we have been talking about living the type of life that is true to ourselves and true to who God has created us to be. On Graduation Sunday, we began with a better understanding of what it meant to flourish by being the best version of ourselves God created even before we were born. Next, we talked about God's desire for us to flourish so that we could experience life to the full today and in the future. The following Sunday, Jacob shared with us about the river of life that is flowing through the Holy Spirit. Then we discovered when it comes to growing closer to God, there wasn't a "one size fits all" approach. Next, we talked about how we needed to surrender all in order for God to take full control of our lives. Most recently, we discovered how our God-given desires can be used to draw us closer to him and to be used for the kingdom.

This week, we will continue our series as we learn to set our minds on things above, not on earthly things as Paul writes in Colossians 3. We have the freedom to decide what our minds will dwell on. We can focus on ourselves and what the world has to offer, or we can focus our minds on God's kingdom. It is a choice we make. My prayer is for us to set our minds on the presence and goodness of God in our lives and allowing the Holy Spirit to flow out of us. Let's talk more about it this week. See you on Sunday!

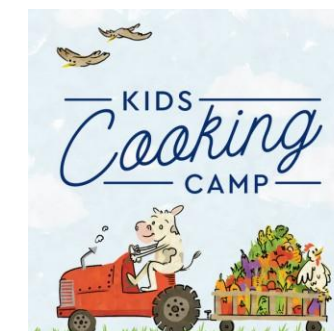
