Words From the Pastor

Over the past year, you've heard me talk a lot about how we can better minister alongside one another, especially with young people. It isn't that young people are more important than those who are more experienced in years. What we've been trying to address is the fact that we are mostly missing an entire generation of young people in the church like no other time in the history of Christianity in our nation. I've consistently reminded us that we can't continue down this road without facing difficult challenges in the near future.

There is a lot we can do structurally to better position ourselves to welcome and engage young adults into our church family. There are a

few things we are currently working on to shift toward this direction. However, though structure is important to help minister alongside young people, there is no substitute for warm relationships. This is the foundation on which all churches grow. Words like *welcoming, accepting, belonging, authentic, hospitable and caring* should be used by people of all ages in the Church. Warmth of a community is not bound to structure, worship style, size of the

congregation or specific programs.

I've had the privilege to teach the principles found in the book *Growing Young* by Fuller Youth Institute to many other Baptist churches in our state. I've fielded calls from churches in Florida, South Dakota, and Ohio asking about the effectiveness of the content found in the book. I've shared with others how we have changed as a congregation in reaching people of all ages, including the young people. I've shared about how we would drive two hours on a bus to support our students who are sharing their wonderful gifts of music as part of the NC Baptist All-State Youth Choir. I've shared about how college students are welcomed in to the congregation and offered the gift of hospitality every Sunday at lunch. I've shared how our Wednesday nights are vibrant with young families with small children and how many of you help care for them. I've shared how our fellowship time before and during the worship service have become more vibrant over the years. I've shared how I truly believe that warmth is now in the DNA of our congregation!

Warmth in a congregation is not a church growth model. It isn't a tool to be used. It is a way of being THE church. The love of God and our love for one another are what connects us together. It is what Jesus taught about time and time again. It is what Paul proclaimed in much of his writings. May we always seek to continue to deepen our relationships across all generations!

This Sunday, we continue our series on The Life I Want To Live by looking at how we do not have to let our hearts be troubled because of God's love for us. See you on Sunday!

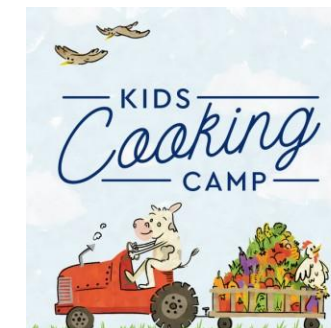
