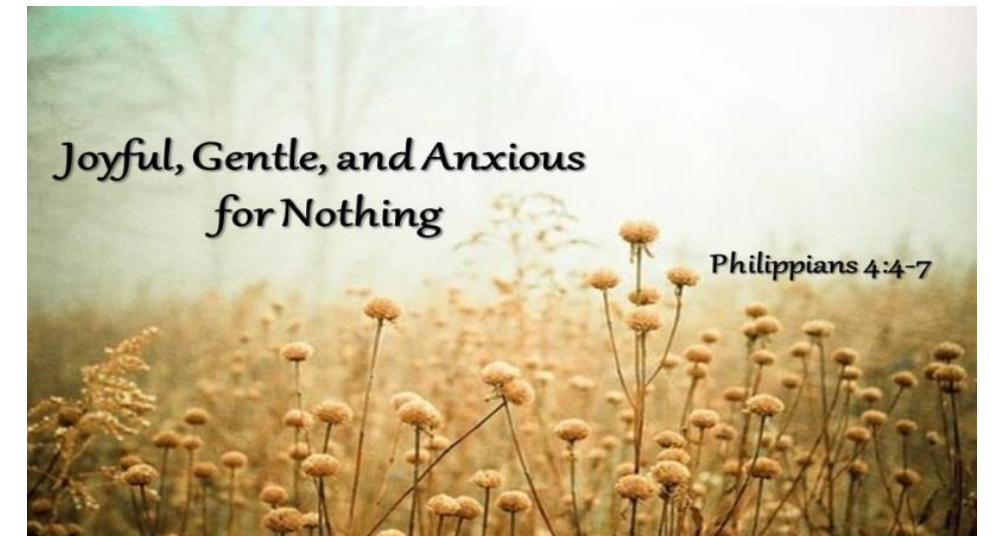

“Learning to Pray”

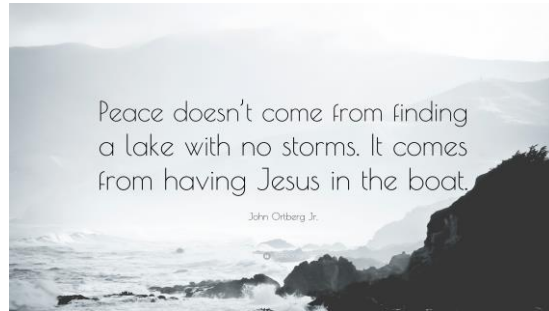
Philippians 4:4-7

Words From the Pastor

This past Sunday, I talked about how we all worry and feel anxiety. Though we may experience worry and anxiety on different levels at different times in our lives, the fact remains that we live in worry and even fear.

Jesus was once napping in a boat with his friends when a storm came up seemingly out of the blue. The disciples were terrified so they woke Jesus up in panic. Jesus, wiping the sleep off of his eyes, looked at the storm and said, "Peace, be still." To the amazement of his friends, nature listened. It was still.

Jesus was a non-anxious presence wherever he went. He carried peace with him. The funny thing is, Jesus never said, "If you follow me, you will never have problems." Jesus faced problems that eventually placed him on the cross. John Ortberg, a pastor and author, says, "Peace doesn't come from finding a lake with no storms. It comes from having Jesus in the boat."



God does not want us to live in worry or fear. He wants us to live with bold confidence in his power. Scripture says, "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline." (2 Timothy 1:7) Time and time again, God proved this to the people who followed him.

God told Abraham to leave everything familiar and go to a land he did not know, and he told him that God himself would give birth to a new nation that would change the world. Abraham went, and a nation was born.

God told Moses to confront Pharaoh – the most powerful man on earth – and that God himself would use Moses' faithfulness to deliver his people. Moses confronted, and God delivered.

God told Joshua that if he would be a strong and courageous leader when everyone wanted to return to slavery, God would go with them and give them the land that was promised to them. Joshua obeyed and God gave them the land.

Time and time again we see this pattern repeated. David faced Goliath, Elijah faced seven hundred prophets of Baal, and Daniel faced the lion's den. Each time, God met them in midst of their worry, fear and anxiety.

We have a faithful God. He keeps his promises. God's peace is offered to us. We just have to embrace it. "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:7) The promise of God is that the Spirit will stand guard over our mind. It isn't about trying harder. It isn't even about praying harder. It is about falling into the tender loving arms of Jesus and letting him care for you, no matter what you are going through. This is the type of **Life I Want to Live!**

This Sunday, we will consider what it would be like if our prayers were actual conversations with God. See you on Sunday!
