### The Smyser-Bair House / Historic York Inn

The Smyser-Bair House / Historic York Inn invites you to join us for an evening of palatial tours, live music, original art, local literature, light fare and drinks at **30 South Beaver Street**

**Berkshire-Hathaway** will offer complete tours of the 1830s mansion, The Smyser-Bair House / Historic York Inn. Step back in time for a tour through history, with hand-carved, gilded Pier mirrors, stained glass, etched glass, hand plasterwork, woodwork, and chandeliers that rival those found in museums. Anchored in the historic district since the 1830s, and belonging to the Smyser-Bair family until 1979, when it was left to the York Historical Trust before becoming a private inn, this home is a rich part of York's history.

**Eric D. Goodman** and **Nataliya Goodman** will sign copies of their books, *Flightless Goose*, a storybook for children, and *Tracks: A Novel in Stories*. *Tracks: A Novel in Stories* won the Gold Medal for best fiction in the Mid Atlantic Region from the Independent Publishers Book Awards.
