Dear Parade Participant:

Welcome to our 54th Annual Laguna Beach Patriots Day Parade. Our parade starts at 11 a.m., Saturday, March 7, 2020, at Laguna Beach High School on Park Avenue and Short Street.

Your entry number and lineup area are indicated above (see below for Location Code). Enclosed are parade rules and a map to direct you to your assembly area. It is essential that you CHECK IN and receive numbered armbands or window cards, so that announcers and spectators can identify your entry along the parade route.

Our 2020 Parade theme is "Everyday Heroes". This is a PATRIOTIC EVENT and we suggest an authentic United States flag or red, white and blue in your entry; no altered U.S. flags are allowed.

Band, Novelty and Float awards will be presented following the parade at Seven7Seven, Art a Fair Grounds, 777 Laguna Canyon Road (near the bus parking), and food and drinks will be for sale there. Auto awards will be given prior to and during the Parade. Autos to be judged should be in place by 8:30 a.m.

Please read our Parade rules, especially: NOTHING can be THROWN or passed out from an entry during the Parade—only distributed from the curb. SKATEBOARDS are not allowed; if not under control, they can become "missiles". Please maintain a steady forward march as directed so we won't have any big gaps. BANDS, please play along the Parade route until the "silent" area.

The Parade is not sponsored by the City or any other organization. We are all volunteers and depend on your suggested entry fee, donations and our program advertisers to cover expenses. Please patronize our advertisers.

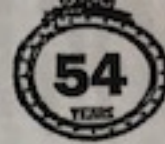

PARADE INFORMATION & RULES

The Parade starts promptly at 11 a.m., Saturday, March 7, at Park Avenue and Short Street, adjacent to Laguna Beach High School.

1. Entry to your ASSEMBLY AREA is shown on the enclosed map.
2. Pre-parade judging of autos is at 8:30 a.m. in their Assembly area.
3. **CHECK-IN FOR ALL ENTRIES:** You must check in before 10:15 at the corner of Park and Short Street and obtain either numbered armbands or window cards and proceed to your assigned location.
ARMBANDS must be displayed on the right arm of the first person in each entry, or cards displayed in the right front windshield of a vehicle entry.
ENTRY NUMBERS ARE IMPORTANT for identification by judges and Parade announcers, as well as spectators.
4. **VEHICLE UNLOADING/PARKING:**
Buses—Unload at High School Football Field (see map) or as directed. Proceed down Parade route past City Hall and park along Laguna Canyon Road facing inland.
Equestrians—Unload on Legion St., then follow parade route past City Hall, turn right on Broadway/Laguna Canyon Road and right on Laguna Canyon Frontage Road and park as directed.
IMPORTANT: AFTER UNLOADING, BEFORE PARADE BEGINS, ALL VEHICLES not part of entry MUST BE MOVED and parked as indicated, NOT IN STAGING AREA.
5. Prior to the Parade, a SHUTTLE vehicle will run on the Parade route between the Peppertree Parking Lot (Forest Av.), City Hall, and Short Street.
6. **PARADE ROUTE:** Starts at Park Avenue and Short Street near High School, proceeds down Park Avenue, turns right on Glenneyre, right on Forest Avenue, ending just past City Hall. (Route is 2/3 mile.) Parade traffic directors will assist with dispersal.
7. The parade is approved and judged by the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association (SCSBOA).
8. **AWARDS:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd in most categories; Band Association Sweepstakes Trophy, Grand Marshal's Award and President's Theme Award. Equestrians are not judged.
9. **AWARDS PRESENTATIONS:** Before the Parade, autos receive awards in their assembly area. All other awards are presented after the parade in the Art A Fair Grounds, 777 Laguna Canyon Road (near bus parking; see the map).
10. **NEED HELP AT THE PARADE?** Look for a Parade Committee person wearing a blue and white shirt or a patriotic cap.
11. The Parade Committee retains the right to remove from the line of march any entry or portion thereof that is deemed inappropriate.

ENTER LAGUNA BEACH from the north via Laguna Canyon Road/Broadway (CA 133) or via Pacific Coast Highway (CA 1). From the south go via Coast Highway. Your **ASSEMBLY AREA** is indicated in the enclosed letter. Enter **STAGING** Area as **EARLY** as possible - the Parade Route is closed off at approximately 10:00 a.m.

To reach the **FOOTBALL FIELD**: (From South) Coast Highway to Thalia Street signal, go right to Wilson stop sign. Turn left on Wilson to Unloading Area. (From North) Coast Highway, turn left at Cleo Street signal, go via El Bosque to the Unloading Area.

To reach the **PARKING LOT**: Coast Highway to Legion Street signal. Turn north one block to Gleneyre, turn left to Park Avenue, then turn right to the High School Parking Lot. **AVOID LEGION STREET** above Gleneyre; it will be congested with horses.

PREJUDGING for Autos at 8:30 a.m. in their staging areas.

AUTO AWARDS presented before and during the parade.

BANDS, FLOATS, NOVELTIES, ALL OTHERS:

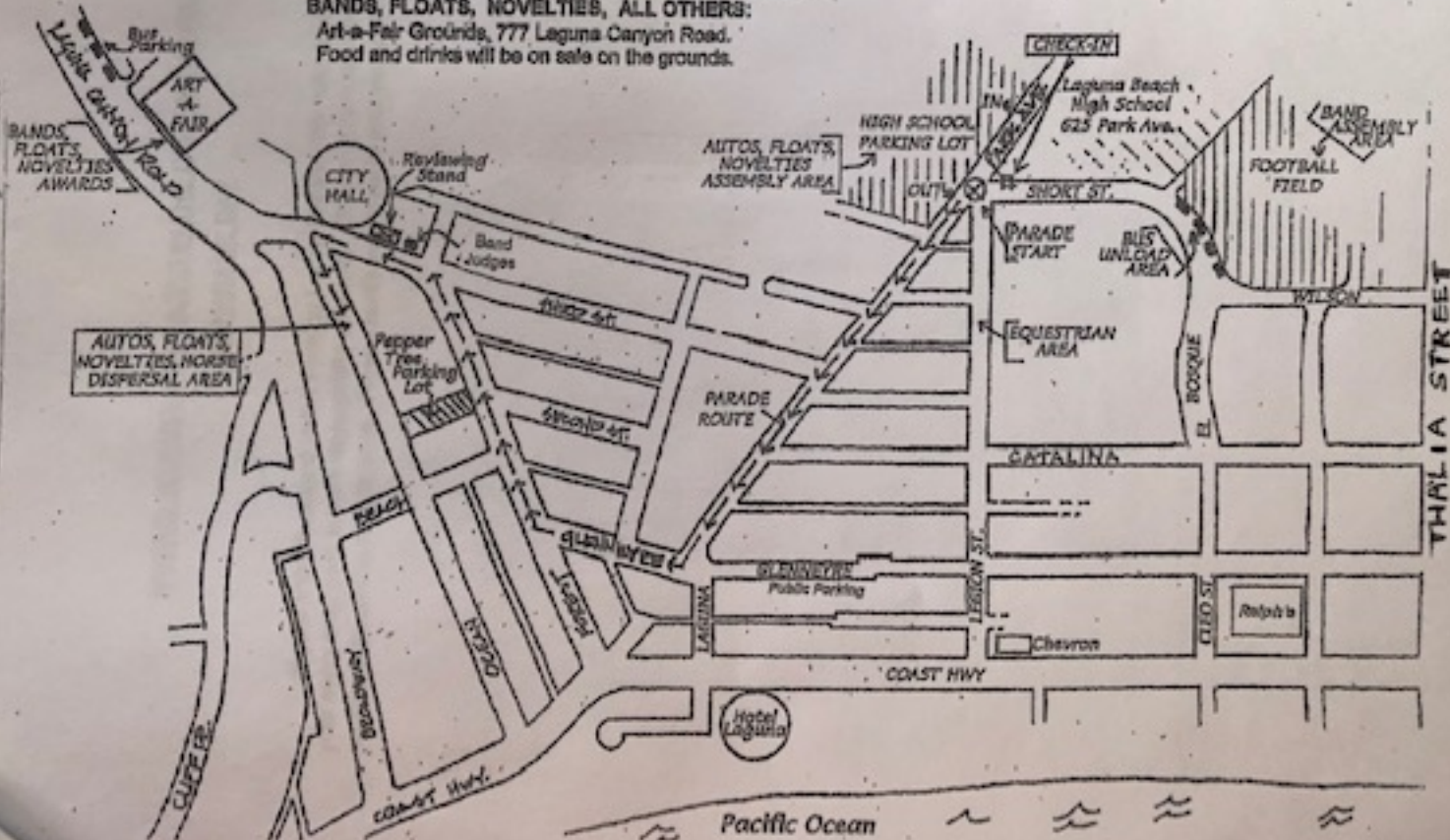
