StreetWorkz is a program designed to meet spiritual and emotional needs of youth in grades 6-8. Mentors guide the students to grow as unique and healthy teens with integrity and faith. Avenues are created for youth to meet God and know His presence in everyday challenges and to stay away from harmful pressures around them. During the school year, StreetWorkz students and mentors gather on Thursdays in BCM's building from 6:30pm-8:30pm. They start off by having dinner together before moving into activities that may include a larger group discussion, games, and small group Bible study led by the mentors.



As an ongoing program, StreetWorkz continues to meet in the summer, although gatherings are less regular and may involve outings.



LiT (Leaders in Training) digs deeply into the subjects of Leadership, Identity and Truth with high school students. With a leadership-discipleship cohort approach, LiT is a relational and flexible program in which students learn about their identity in God and discover how to lead with their unique gifts and strengths. During the school year, the group meets at BCM's building on Tuesday evenings from 6:30pm-8:30pm. Gatherings begin by the mentors and students having dinner together before transitioning into activities, discussion or games. Service projects are also integrated into the program.

As an ongoing program, LiT meets in the summer, although gatherings are less regular and may involve outings.
