Dave Ullman was Mystery Guest #43 in 2008. He is a decorated international yachtsman, sailboat racer and sailmaker; winner of three 470 World Championships who grew up sailing in Southern California. Ullman started Ullman Sails, first located in Newport Beach, in 1967 which led to his international sailing career.

Ullman was named Rolex Yachtsman of the Year in 1996, and was nominated again in 2007. He is also the 2007 Melges 24 World Champion, a five-time Lipton Cup Champion (1992-1996), a ten-time Lido 14 National Champion, and a National Champion in the Snipe, Thistle, Sabot and Coronado 15 racing classes. Ullman is also an S.O.R.C. class-winning skipper, a U.S. Team Racing Champion, a U.S. Men's National Champion (Mallory Cup) and a former coach of the U.S. Olympic Sailing Team.
