

HOW

Training

The course is delivered in the following ways:

- **Online live classes** with a qualified trainer/assessor at an Apex Training Institute via Zoom or other webinar software.
- **Simulated work environment:** There is a simulated work environment in the Apex campus that is used for training in hands-on skills.
- **Online:** All learning materials are placed online in written and video format and are accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



- **Actual work environment:** Part of the learning takes place during 280 hours of vocational placement in an actual child care facility.
- Face to face delivery with a qualified trainer/assessor at an Apex Training Institute campus.
- PowerPoints and other **supplementary materials**.

Assessment

You are assessed via the following tools:

- Short questions
- Case studies
- Research activities
- Observations in a simulated work environment
- Observation in an actual work environment
- Student journals
- Observation checklist by a qualified assessor
- Portfolios

The online training and assessment can be conducted from anywhere there is an Internet connection in the world. Your assessment in a simulated workplace will take place at an Apex Training Institute campus.

Your vocational placement, and observation in an actual workplace, can be organised from anywhere in Australia.

PREREQUISITES AND COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Complete the CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care qualification.
- Essential requirements to participate in this course are the ability to communicate in an English workplace effectively. An Apex member of staff may conduct a brief language and literacy assessment during the application process.
- If working or completing work placement in an organisation that has children within Queensland, students will require a Working with Children Check (Blue Card).



• Kindly note that we will need your Unique Student Identifier (USI) within 14 days of enrolment at Apex. Apex might also request access to your USI transcript at any stage during your studies. This transcript will be accessed in line with our privacy policies and procedures.

- 2. Your application form will be assessed for viability. If your application is approved, you proceed to the next step; if not, you cannot enrol at Apex Training Institute. Additionally, there might be some cases where you need to fulfil some requirements before your application can be approved; an Apex team member will advise if this is the case.
- 3. Once you have enrolled, you can make a payment via one of the aforementioned payment methods.

Once we have received payments, we will send you your enrollment information and student onboarding information within 1 business week.

FAQ

HOW LONG DOES THE COURSE/QUALIFICATION TAKE?

At Apex study is self-paced. As soon as you enrol, we give you access to all knowledge training materials and assessments. You can also attend an unlimited number of face to face classes, online



live classes and support sessions for up to **24 months** from when you enrol. The face to face schedule can be accessed 24/7/365 from the Apex website:

https://www.apextraining.edu.au/resources. To participate in a support session and/or online live class, you are required to liaise with a member of the Apex support team who will advise about availability and timing.

The combination of these resources means you can go through the knowledge component of your study as quickly or slowly as you please. To complete studies on a part-time schedule, you will need to dedicate **10-19 hours per week** to self-study. To complete studies on a full-time schedule, you will need to dedicate **20-40 hours a week** to self-study.

You must complete **280 hours** of practical work placement in a child care facility. 280 hours equates to between 6-7 weeks, if you attend for 7.5 hours a day, Monday to Friday. It equates to 12 weeks if you attend for 4 hours a day, Monday to Friday.

According to the Australian Qualifications Framework, the Volume of Learning for this course is **1-2 years.**

Yes, we assist you in finding a vocational placement. There are no extra charges for receiving training and assessment services while at work placement or for assistance finding a placement.

We strongly encourage students to find their work placement whenever possible for the following reasons:

- One learns how to job hunt effectively, which is a great skill to have.
- One develops a relationship with the employer. This relationship, more often than not, leads to employment.
- It encourages students with weak communication skills to develop their communication skills.

You most certainly can. There are several things that can be done to reduce the amount of time and units you need to study including:

 previous formal and informal education among other things
- Recognition of statements of attainments issued by other RTOs Also known as Credit
 Transfer
